Besser Museum for Northeast Michigan Treasurer's Report June 16, 2020 Board Meeting (May Financials)

Notes/Highlights to May Financial Statement:

With the Museum closed since March 24, 2020 due to Governor's Orders regarding Covid-19, the actual revenues and expenditures are very different than the budget for 2019-2020. With one month to go in the fiscal year, highlights are as follows:

Revenues:

- *\$42,700 Payroll Protection Loan received—as of now reported as a loan. Application will be made later and hopefully approved to change to a grant and then it will be reported as income.
- *\$5,000 Michigan Humanities HOPE Grant received—Covid-related grant.
- *\$2,500 MCACA Grant awarded, will be received in June—Covid-related grant.
- *\$5,000 private donation received.

Expenditures: With the closure of the Museum, expenditures have been slowed considerably as would be expected.

Bottom Line:

Total Revenues minus total expenditures produced a net revenue of \$38,775 through May 2020.
